

One Another Statements in the New Testament

Here are 45 of the things that we are told to do with regards to one another or each other in the New Testament:

1. **Accept or welcome** one another. Romans 15:7 (AMP) "Therefore, [continue to] accept and welcome one another, just as Christ has accepted and welcomed us to the glory of [our great] God."
2. **Be at peace** with each other. Mark 9:50 (NLT) "Be at peace with each other."
3. **Be kind, helpful and compassionate** to one another, **forgiving** each other. Ephesians 4:32 (AMP) "Be kind and helpful to one another, tender-hearted [compassionate, understanding], forgiving one another [readily and freely], just as God in Christ also forgave you."
4. **Be like minded (agree)** so that there may be no division. 2 Corinthians 13:11 (AMPC) "Finally, brethren, farewell (rejoice)! Be strengthened (perfected, completed, made what you ought to be); be encouraged and consoled and comforted; be of the same [agreeable] mind one with another; live in peace, and [then] the God of love [Who is the Source of affection, goodwill, love, and benevolence toward men] and the Author and Promoter of peace will be with you."
5. **Be patient** with one another. Ephesians 4:2b (AMP) "With patience, bearing with one another in [unselfish] love."
6. **Build up** one another. Romans 14:19 (AMP) "So then, let us pursue [with enthusiasm] the things which make for peace and the building up of one another [things which lead to spiritual growth]."
7. **Care** for each other. 1 Corinthians 12:25 (NLT) "This makes for harmony among the members, so that all the members care for each other."
8. **Comfort and encourage** one another. 1 Thessalonians 4:18 (AMPC) "Therefore comfort and encourage one another with these words."
9. **Confess your faults and sins** to one another, **praying** for each other. James 5:16a (AMPC) "Confess to one another therefore your faults (your slips, your false steps, your offenses, your sins) and pray [also] for one another, that you may be healed and restored [to a spiritual tone of mind and heart]."
10. **Consider others more important** than yourselves. Philippians 2:3 (CEV) "Don't be jealous or proud, but be humble and consider others more important than yourselves."
11. **Do good** to each other. 1 Thessalonians 5:15 (NLT) "See that no one pays back evil for evil, but always try to do good to each other and to all people."
12. **Don't be jealous or proud.** Philippians 2:3 (CEV) "Don't be jealous or proud, but be humble and consider others more important than yourselves."
13. **Don't be self-conceited, competitive and challenging and provoking and irritating** one another, **envying** and being **jealous** of one another. Galatians 5:26 (AMPC) "Let us not become vainglorious and self-conceited, competitive and challenging and provoking and irritating to one another, envying and being jealous of one another."
14. **Don't criticize, blame or pass judgment** on one another. Romans 14:13 (AMPC) "Then let us no more criticize and blame and pass judgment on one another, but rather decide and endeavour never to put a stumbling block or an obstacle or a hindrance in the way of a brother."
15. **Don't destroy** one another. Galatians 5:15 (NLT) "But if you are always biting and devouring one another, watch out! Beware of destroying one another."
16. **Don't grumble** about each other. James 5:9 (NLT) "Don't grumble about each other, brothers and sisters, or you will be judged. For look - the Judge is standing at the door!"
17. **Don't lie** to each other. Colossians 3:9 (NLT) "Don't lie to each other, for you have stripped off your old sinful nature and all its wicked deeds."
18. **Don't slander or judge** one another. James 4:11 (NIV) "Brothers and sisters, do not slander one another. Anyone who speaks against a brother or sister or judges them speaks against the law and judges it. When you judge the law, you are not keeping it, but sitting in judgment on it."
19. **Encourage and build** one another **up**. 1 Thessalonians 5:11 (NIV) "Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing." Hebrews 10:25 (NLT) "And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near."
20. **Encourage** one another **daily**. Hebrews 3:13 (AMP) "But continually encourage one another every day, as long as it is called 'Today' [and there is an opportunity], so that none of you will be hardened [into settled rebellion] by the deceitfulness of sin [its cleverness, delusive glamour, and sophistication]."
21. Have **equal concern** for one another. 1 Corinthians 12:24b-25 (AMP) "But God has combined the [whole] body, giving greater honour to that part which lacks it, so that there would be no division or discord in the body [that is, lack of adaptation of the parts to each other], but that the parts may have the same concern for one another."

22. **Forgive** one another. Colossians 3:13 (NLT), "Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others." Ephesians 4:32 (NLT) "Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you."
23. **Greet** one another **warmly**. Romans 16:16 (CEV) "Be sure to give each other a warm greeting." 2 Corinthians 13:12 (CEV) "Give each other a warm greeting." 1 Peter 5:14a (CEV) "Give each other a warm greeting."
24. **Grow in love** for another. 1 Thessalonians 3:12 (NLT) "And may the Lord make your love for one another and for all people grow and overflow, just as our love for you overflows." 1 Thessalonians 4:9-10 (NLT) "But we don't need to write to you about the importance of loving each other, for God himself has taught you to love one another. Indeed, you already show your love for all the believers throughout Macedonia. Even so, dear brothers and sisters, we urge you to love them even more."
25. **Honour** and **love** one another. Romans 12:10 (NLT) "Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honouring each other."
26. Clothe yourselves with **humility** towards one another. 1 Peter 5:5 (NLT) "And all of you, dress yourselves in humility as you relate to one another, for God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."
27. **Instruct** and **teach** one another. Romans 15:14 (CEV) "My friends, I am sure that you are very good and that you have all the knowledge you need to teach each other." Colossians 3:16 (CEV) "Let the message about Christ completely fill your lives, while you use all your wisdom to teach and instruct each other."
28. **Live in harmony** with one another. Romans 15:5 (NLT) "May God, who gives this patience and encouragement, help you live in complete harmony with each other, as is fitting for followers of Christ Jesus." Romans 12:16 (NLT) "Live in harmony with each other. Don't be too proud to enjoy the company of ordinary people. And don't think you know it all!"
29. **Look out** for one another's **interests**. Philippians 2:4 (AMP) "Do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others."
30. **Love** one another. John 13:34 (NIV) "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another." John 15:12 (NLT) "This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you." John 15:17 (NLT) "This is my command: Love each other." Romans 13:8 (NLT) "Owe nothing to anyone - except for your obligation to love one another. If you love your neighbour, you will fulfil the requirements of God's law." 1 Peter 1:22 (NLT) "You were cleansed from your sins when you obeyed the truth, so now you must show sincere love to each other as brothers and sisters. Love each other deeply with all your heart." 1 John 4:11-12 (NLT) "Dear friends, since God loved us that much, we surely ought to love each other. No one has ever seen God. But if we love each other, God lives in us, and his love is brought to full expression in us." 1 Peter 3:8 (NLT) "Love each other as brothers and sisters." Romans 12:10a (NLT) "Love each other with genuine affection."
31. **Offer hospitality** to one another. 1 Peter 4:9 (NIV) "Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling."
32. **Pray** for each other. James 5:16b (NLT) "Pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results." Matthew 5:44 (AMP) "But I say to you, love [that is, unselfishly seek the best or higher good for] your enemies and pray for those who persecute you."
33. **Put up (bear with)** and **forgive** one another. Colossians 3:13 (CEV) "Put up with each other, and forgive anyone who does you wrong, just as Christ has forgiven you."
34. **Seek the best** for one another. 1 John 3:11 (AMP) "For this is the message which you [believers] have heard from the beginning [of your relationship with Christ], that we should [unselfishly] love and seek the best for one another."
35. In love, **serve** one another. Galatians 5:13 (AMPC) "For you, brethren, were [indeed] called to freedom; only [do not let your] freedom be an incentive to your flesh and an opportunity or excuse [for selfishness], but through love you should serve one another."
36. **Share** one another's **burdens**. Galatians 6:2 (NLT) "Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ."
37. **Speak the truth** to one another. Ephesians 4:25 (AMP) "Therefore, rejecting all falsehood [whether lying, defrauding, telling half-truths, spreading rumours, any such as these], speak truth each one with his neighbour, for we are all parts of one another [and we are all parts of the body of Christ]."
38. **Submit** to one another. Ephesians 5:21 (NLT) "And further, submit to one another out of reverence for Christ."
39. **Sympathize** with each other. **Be tenderhearted** and **keep a humble attitude**. 1 Peter 3:8 (NLT) "Finally, all of you should be of one mind. Sympathize with each other. Love each other as brothers and sisters. Be tenderhearted, and keep a humble attitude."

40. **Use your spiritual gifts to serve** one another. 1 Peter 4:10 (NLT) “God has given each of you a gift from his great variety of spiritual gifts. Use them well to serve one another.”
41. **Wait** for one another when taking communion. 1 Corinthians 11:33 (AMPC) “So then, my brothers, when you gather together to eat [the Lord’s Supper], wait for one another.”
42. **Watch over** one another, **inspiring** each other **to do good deeds**. Hebrews 10:24 (AMPC) “And let us consider and give attentive, continuous care to watching over one another, studying how we may stir up (stimulate and incite) to love and helpful deeds and noble activities.”
43. **Warn** one another. Hebrews 3:13 (AMPC) “But instead warn (admonish, urge, and encourage) one another every day, as long as it is called ‘Today,’ that none of you may be hardened [into settled rebellion] by the deceitfulness of sin [by the fraudulence, the stratagem, the trickery which the delusive glamor of his sin may play on him].”
44. **Wash** one another’s **feet**. John 13:14 (AMPC) “If I then, your Lord and Teacher (Master), have washed your feet, you ought [it is your duty, you are under obligation, you owe it] to wash one another’s feet.”
45. **We all belong** to each other. Romans 12:5 (NLT) “So it is with Christ’s body. We are many parts of one body, and we all belong to each other.” Ephesians 4:25b (NIV) “For we are all members of one body.”
